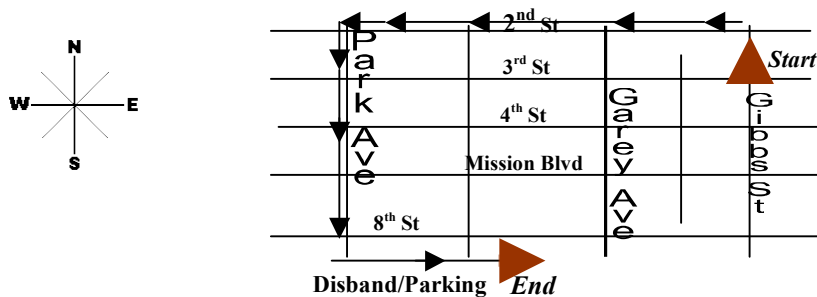

1. Santa will be our special guest in the parade, please no impersonators.
2. You must be in line and prepared for judging at the appropriate time, specifically the Bands/Groups being judged by the SCSBOA.
3. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by drivers or any participants before or during the parade is strictly forbidden.
4. Autos and large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver. Small vehicles (mini-bikes, small tractors, go-carts, etc.) must be operated by a person age 12 or older.
5. Parade participants are not permitted to leave vehicles to demonstrate in any street or to stop or slow the forward movement of the parade in any way.
6. Throwing items such as gifts, candy or brochures during the parade is prohibited.
7. When disbanding on 8th St., units shall not block the flow of traffic for participants behind. Christmas Parade Officials will direct the disbanding, which will be near the City's Holiday at the Plaza event.
8. Please provide your own banner(s) with your group's name that will go in front of your line, float or on the sides of your vehicle. Please contact the DPOA for exceptions.
9. Exceptions to the rules may be made only with the approval of the Christmas Parade Officials.
10. If you are a band, JROTC, or riding in a vehicle or float, please keep in mind the widths of the streets. Second St. is 23.7 feet wide. Park Ave., where the SCSBOA judges will be located, is 63 feet wide. Gibbs and 8th Streets are 46 feet wide. Disbanding will be at 8th and Thomas St. All buses, cars, carriers, horse trailers, etc., will be directed to appropriate parking by parade officials. No vehicles over 14 feet high are permitted on the parade route.

Parade Day Information

1. Registration will be in Downtown Pomona in the south east parking lot at 3rd and Gibbs St. Look for signs. Registration starts at 7:00am. All participants must be registered no later than 9:00am. Please be on time. The parade will start promptly at 10am, rain or shine.



2. Route: Parade staging will be at 3rd and Gibbs St. The parade will go west on 2nd St. to Park Ave. At Park Ave. the parade will go south to 8th St. At 8th St. parade will go east to disband. It's approximately one mile. Judging for bands will be held on Park Ave.
3. Parade line-up and route is subject to change at anytime.
4. Awards and certificates will be presented at the Holiday at the Plaza event. Holiday at the Plaza will be at City Hall's outdoor Civic Center from 11-3pm. Parade awards will begin at approximately 12pm.
